## Easy

Easy plants complete a full reproductive cycle in one growing season. They also usually self-pollinate, so you don't have to worry about cross-pollination from a different plant.

## Medium

Medium plants complete a full reproductive cycle in one growing year, but they may rely on insects for pollination and are capable of cross-pollination. These plants require planning in order to ensure pure seeds.

## Hard

Difficult plants can take two years to complete a full reproductive cycle, bu they will cross-pollination. Special care such as hand-pollination or caging is needed to ensure pure seeds.
