## MUSKEGON AREA DISTRICT LIBRARY BEGINS CURBSIDE SERVICE

Muskegon, MI, June 15, 2020- The Muskegon Area District Library (MADL) will begin curbside and new enhanced services today. Curbside service is an easy and safe way for people to pick up checked-out materials from their car.

Patrons can place holds online or on the phone and pick them up at the from the convenience of their car. Once they receive notice that their items are ready for Pick-up, they can visit the branch library during open hours and park in the designated Curbside Pick-up area. They will call the number listed on the parking lot sign and a staff member will bring the item to them. Curbside RETURNS for all checked out materials continue.

Branch libraries will also open for one-hour computer sessions available by appointment only.

Patrons can call the branch library to schedule an appointment.

Printing services from home will now be offered. The public can send print jobs to the library from their computer or mobile device by downloading the library print app and uploading their documents. Then they can visit any branch library to pick up the print job. Ten pages per person per day will be free.

Summer Programs, including the Summer Reading Club, also kick off this week. Many programs for kids, teens and adults are available. People can enjoy FREE virtual programs and many other online events in the convenience of their homes.
