



The LVPD is now able to loan Braille eReaders through the National Library Service for the Blind and Print Disabled (NLS).

The NLS Braille eReader allows NLS patrons to read electronic braille files (BRFs) as well as Word files, HTML files, DAISY files, and PDF files. The unit has 20 braille cells, a Perkins-style keyboard, 16GB of internal memory, and the ability to use an SD card and a USB drive for external storage. It connects to Wi-Fi so that braille files can be downloaded directly from BARD and has Bluetooth capability so patrons can connect directly to a smartphone and read the info on the screen in braille. It also can connect to a computer so that the information on the screen will be displayed on the braille display.








NEW ADDITIONS TO THE LIBRARY OF THINGS

Our library system, Muskegon Area District Library (MADL), has added some new accessibility items to its Library of Things. A Library of Things is a collection of non-traditional materials such as games, tools, and kits that are available for check out.

The first group of these are magnifiers, with two handheld magnifiers with 3-5x magnification, one LED page magnifier with 3x magnification, and two LED page magnifiers with 5x magnification. The second group are colorblind glasses, with three sets of adult indoor glasses and one set of children's indoor glasses.

All of these are available for checkout through your local public library.
