An Update from **Kelly Richards, Director** 

## **ENHANCED SERVICES** FOR OUR COMMUNITY

Many new and enhanced services are underway at the Muskegon Area District Library. These are exciting times of change and technological improvements. We are making these improvements at all 10 area branches to provide our patrons with new levels of service in 2017.

Libraries are really about transforming people through access to information. In the past, that meant access to books. But for the next generation of libraries, information means everything from internet connections, iPads and Maker Spaces—where the community is provided space and tools for learning. An emerging library "service" is its wi-fi connections, which can be used separately from the hours library buildings are open.

New technology advances in the works include:

- We have recently installed additional AWE Early Literacy Stations<sup>™</sup> (ELS) so that every branch will be equipped with this early literacy computer program. These stations are designed specifically for young learners ages 2-8, and include over 4,000 learning activities. All branches will now have at least one ELS, and three branches will have the After School Edge machines for slightly older children.
- The new Hoopla database will allow public availability of thousands of movies, television shows, music albums, eBooks, audiobooks and comics, all available for mobile and online access at madl.org.
- We are improving wi-fi speed and coverage area by installing new wireless equipment.
- New adaptive computer technology at the Library for the Blind and Physically Handicapped.
- MADL will be replacing all public computers with new ones over a three year period, and increasing the number of public access computers. Half of the computers will be replaced by summer, 2017.

# **Muskegon Area District Library Receives** \$92,328 from Anonymous Donor

The Muskegon Area District Library has received a generous donation to support improvements at the "Walker Memorial" Branch Library in North Muskegon. An anonymous donor has expressed tremendous library support with a \$92,328 donation. The gift is designated to be used for construction/expansion of a new library facility in North Muskegon.

"We are so thankful for this generous gift and the confidence it shows to support significant library programs and services for our community," says Kelly Richards, Director of the Muskegon Area District Library, Since its opening in 1969, the North Muskegon Branch has been a popular and active community gathering place." As we move further into the 21st century, the more our library will be called upon to meet the learning and information needs of the community."

The North Muskegon "Walker Memorial" Branch is one of 10 branch local libraries operated by the Muskegon Area District Library. In 2015, there were 74,792 people who visited this branch. The building is owned and maintained by the City of North Muskegon. All library materials, services, programs and staff are provided by the Muskegon Area District Library.

The Muskegon Area District Library is always thankful for donations as they help support our mission to provide services to the public.

# Library for the Blind Update

Muskegon's only Library for the Blind and Physically Handicapped is in for a big change. The LBPH provides talking books and talking book playback equipment in digital format. Plans are underway to transform this service into an Adaptive Technology Lab serving patrons in Muskegon and Ottawa counties. Additional services will include a high demand circulating audio visual and book collection, and accessible space and equipment for the physically handicapped.

The new improvement plans for the Advisory Outreach Center include the relocation and expansion of the existing LBPH. It will relocate from its existing space to an adjoining space at the Administrative Office, 4845 Airline Road, adding adaptive equipment and furniture.

"I'm excited to see us move forward with enhanced services for our BPH patrons," says Sheila Miller, LBPH Librarian. "I know our patrons will welcome and enjoy a more accessible and comfortable library environment." The plans include new adaptive work stations, computer stations, seating and tables for study areas and upgrading the space for efficiency and enhanced functionality.

MADL is working with the Sidock Group, Inc. architectural and engineering firm in Muskegon on this project. Once

an overall plan design is approved, construction will begin in the first quarter of 2017. Upon completion, there will be an open house for the public with demonstrations and tours.

# Muskegon Township Branch, East Muskegon's Hidden Jewel

After 69 years of bookmobile service to neighborhoods throughout Muskegon County the bookmobile was officially retired in 2009. The bookmobile's home base was at the Muskegon Township offices. Then in July of that year, the youngest branch of the Muskegon Area District Library, (MADL) was born: the Muskegon Township Branch.



Housed in the Orchard View Community Education building on Ada Avenue, the branch consists of one room in a former elementary school. All of MADL's services are available including access to computers, a book club and Story Time for children.

Pam Knight, who coordinates the branch, says that although the branch may appear small, she keeps the book collection up to date and full of materials she knows people want. According to Knight, "In the past seven years the biggest challenge has been letting people know we are here." With a growing customer base, a new successful adult book club has begun to meet monthly.

Located one block off of Apple Avenue, township residents appreciate that they have a community asset at the library. Last summer, the Muskegon Township Branch had tremendous attendance at its summer reading program with nearly 800 people.

According to Knight, "It helps that we have access to the school's gymnasium, a perfect place for kids to enjoy programs." The positive synergy with day care in the building, Head Start Preschool Program and Orchard View Community Education sharing announcements of children's programs has built up a following over time.

The Muskegon Area District Library has 10 community branches, and works closely with local municipalities to provide great programs and services. The Muskegon township branch has one of the largest populations with just over 18,000 residents.

The Orchard View Community Education program has been a valuable partner and we appreciate the successful collaboration we have with them.
