You have now registered for your home library collection on Libby! To add more, we will need to switch between the home tab, and the menu tab at the bottom of the screen.

1. From the menu tab, you should choose "Add a Library." You will then be prompted to search for a library by name.

2. When you find and select one of the partnering library collections, you will be taken to their home page with their logo in the upper left hand corner. Choose Sign in With My Card.

3. This time, you need to pick the Lakeland Digital Library from the partner libraries . Do NOT look for a MADL branch under the main library list.

4. Enter you MADL library card number.



5. You should now see a card showing you the number of holds and checkouts you have available with this collection. 6. Now if you are on the Home tab, you should see the new logo in the upper left hand corner of the screen.





Once you have multiple libraries added to Libby, you can easily switch between them on the Menu tab or when you perform a search.

1. Find all of you libraries on the menu tab. The one with the star is the one you're currently in.

2. Perform a search and look for the card icon next to the item you want. 3. Click on the icon to see what other libraries have the item and what your wait time might be.



You can use all your cards to put holds on the same item if you'd like. Just don't forget to cancel your unnecessary holds when you're done!

Each library has a different collection for their communities, so it's important to look around and discover which one suits you the best! Try them all today.
